## Rules Of Entry

Reference to the word "Awards" shall mean the Queensland Brides Design Awards; to the word "Organisers" shall mean Queensland Brides magazine. The Organisers reserve the right to amend or add to these rules at any time and any change will be binding on all participants.

- 1. The closing date for entries will be shown on the Entry Form and no entries will be accepted or entered into after that date.
- The Organisers reserve the right to appoint judges for the Awards.
- 3. The Organisers shall take care of all garments, however no responsibility for loss or damage will be taken during the time that such entries are held by the Organisers.
- 4. Dressing room facilities shall be provided by the Organisers on the day of the function.
- 5. The order in which the categories and entries in each category shall be judged will be decided by the Organiser.
- 6. Entry Fees shall be shown on the Entry Form and no variation shall be made.
- Entrants shall be required to supply a short description of their entry/entries at least two weeks prior to assist the presentation commentary on the day of the Awards. (form supplied)
- 8. The Organisers will not be liable to any party as a consequence of any act, error or omission on their part or the part of any servant howsoever occurring in connection with the Awards.
- 9. It is desirable that all entrants be present at the Awards events

- 10. It will be the responsibility of the entrants to collect their entry/entries at the close of the Awards function.
- 11. Entry Fees are non-refundable after the entry close date.
- 12. Entrants may enter a maximum of two entries in any one category.
- 13. All entrants will be responsible for providing their own model, hair and make-up.
- 14. All entrants shall be responsible for providing protection and care of their entry/entries and accessories used by models.
- 15. Garments must be hung on hangers only.
- 16. The organisers reserve the right to combine categories or to withdraw a category, if in its opinion there are insufficient entries.
- 17. To enable smooth running of the parade, a model shall not be engaged by more than one entrant.
- 18. Female garment sizes should be size 8, 10 or 12.
- 19. Decisions by the Organisers in relation to any matter arising with respect to the Awards shall be final and binding on all parties.
- 20. The judges and Organisers reserve the right to re-assign entries to sections more suitable to the garments/s.
- 21. Please note: A prejudging run through will be held on the afternoon of the 11th for all categories.
